We Offer

- The function is based on your knowledge and experience. This means you will be scaled in scale LB, starting at € 3.463,- and ending at € 5.277,- per month (cao vo gross per month based on a fulltime employment).
- Of course, you will receive a travel allowance, a good pension, 8% holiday allowance, time off during school holidays, and a fixed year-end bonus of 8.33%.
- A personal budget of 50 hours with a full-time employment. You can use this as desired. For example, you have the option to exercise, an extra day off for a weekend away, shopping at Coolblue, Bol.com etc.
